

Getting to London from the Airport

For guidance on getting from the airport to central London, see:

Heathrow Airport: <http://www.heathrowairport.com/> Heathrow is 15 minutes from Paddington station (Circle line). (See also below).

Stansted Airport: <http://www.stanstedairport.com/> Stansted is 46 minutes from Liverpool St Station (Metropolitan, Circle and Hammersmith and City lines).

The conference site

The conference site is in the East End of London, at the Queen Mary University of London (QMUL) Mile End campus on Mile End Road.

By Underground, you can walk 5-10 minutes to the campus from either the Mile End station (Central, District and Hammersmith and City lines) or Stepney Green station (District and Hammersmith and City lines). See [Walking directions to QMUL Mile End Campus from the Underground](#).

Overview of Heathrow to London options:

You can get to London from Heathrow by either car, bus, taxi, or train.

Car

It takes approximately 45-60 minutes to get to central London from Heathrow. When leaving Terminals 1, 2 and 3, follow exit signs to the access/exit tunnel. Follow signs to the M4 motorway, which will eventually bring you into London. Terminal 4 is on the main A30 road. The M4 and M25 orbital are signposted. Again, follow signs to the M4 which will eventually bring you into London.

Bus

There are National Express coaches operating from Terminal 1, 2, 3 and 4 to cities across the UK and into central London. Passengers landing at terminal 4 needing coaches from the central bus station can take the Heathrow Express which takes 5 minutes.

There is a Heathrow Hotel Hoppa service which connects Heathrow with local hotels. Tickets can be bought from the self service machines at the airport's bus stops, from the driver or from the hotel. Tickets cost £3, one child 5-15 can travel with an adult and children under 5 travel free.

Taxi

Follow the signs in each terminal Arrivals areas for taxi ranks. The journey time to central London is approximately 45-60 minutes and will cost you between £35 and £45.

Train

Heathrow has two rail services to central London. In addition to the London Underground there is the Heathrow Express service to London Paddington station.
